Trades Related Experience

- **Roofing** - Install composite shingles on two outdoor structures. Worked from ladder to move roofing material to deck. Mount roofing vents, and finish with cap. Installed shingles using a pneumatic roofing nailer, hand tools, utility knife and tin snips. Installed flashing as necessary.
- **Remodeling** – Deconstruct existing lathe and plaster ceiling and remove debris to dumpster. Worked with crew to replace rafters as necessary on 16” center layout. Installed drywall blocking in each corner. Cut blocking with circular saw and installed using framing hammer and sinkers from ladder.
- **Built Fencing** – plumb and brace 4x4 pressure treated posts; hand-mix and pour concrete around posts. Install horizontal fencing members using a cordless drill and 6’ level. Installed vertical 1x6 cedar panels using galvanized nails and finish hammer. Ensured each panel was plumb. Scribed and cut the lower portion of panel as necessary to allow for existing tree roots, using a jigsaw.
- **Commercial Mezzanine Construction** – worked with crew to install 3x9” angle iron to existing walls as a ledger for mezzanine level. Fastened using lag bolts and a socket set. Cut 2x6 lumber to length using a circular saw and installed on ledger. Created a monolithic glulam floor by laminating each 2x6 ply to the next using construction adhesive, a caulk gun, a pneumatic framing nailer and an A-frame ladder.
